Chapter 16.5: Wireless Emergency Telephone System

§ 7-8-16.5-43 WIRELESS EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM FUND.

(A) The County Wireless Emergency Telephone System Fund is hereby created.

(B) All wireless emergency 911 funds received by the county from the Wireless Enhanced Advisory Board pursuant to I.C. 36-8-16.5-39 shall be deposited by the County Treasurer in the County Wireless Emergency Telephone System Fund to be used for purposes allowed by I.C. 36-8-16.5-41. Chapter 9: Establishing Positions

§ 7-10-9-1 911 DISPATCH SUPERVISOR.

There is hereby established position of 911 Dispatch Supervisor.

(A) *Funding.* This position shall be funded out of the 911 funds received by the county. All employee benefits and expenses for the 911 Dispatch Supervisor shall be paid from the County 911 funds.

(B) *Description.* The 911 Dispatch Supervisor shall be responsible for 911 dispatch supervision of all dispatchers employed by the county, coordination of 911 dispatch functions with law enforcement, training 911 dispatchers and scheduling and staffing of 911 dispatch. This is a full-time, salaried position with the county.

(C) *Supervision.* The 911 Dispatch Coordinator shall be under the supervision of the County Board of Commissioners and under the direct supervision of the County 911 Coordinator.

(D) *Benefits.* The 911 Dispatch Supervisor shall be entitled to the same benefits as any other regular county employee and subject to the same personnel policies applicable to all county employees. (Ord. 2001-5, passed 6-29-2001)
