

Minutes from the Monthly Meeting of the
Jefferson County Park Board

January 14, 2019

The Jefferson County Park Board gathered at the Broadway. President Gil McCoy called the meeting to order at 5:13 p.m. with members Richard Hill, and Kevin Lichlyter in attendance. Commissioner Little was also in attendance. The November minutes were reviewed and approved.

Old Business

Commissioner Little reported that a 16-point buck was taken in our hunt this season. Various improvements for the hunts for next season were discussed and will be considered. Those changes may include: doing an "earn a buck" policy where hunters would be required to take at least one doe before taking a buck; expanding to three-day hunts rather than two day hunts; and, going back to issuing windshield permits for the hunters to display.

Richard reported that two large trees fell across the back road at Krueger during the ice storm in November. He had our mower remove them at a cost of \$275.

We also brought the need for gravel and spillway clearance. Commissioner Little will get with the highway department on that.

New Business

Richard will look into the possibility of having turkey hunts this year.

Kevin reported the race dates for this year. They are as follows:

March 30 - the boat club will stain the stand and have testing (March 31 rain date).

April 27 - test tune (April 28 rain date)

May 11 - Club race (May 12 rain date)

June 8 - Club race (June 9 rain date)

July 20 - Club race (July 21 rain date)

August 17 - Club race (August 18 rain date)

September 14 - Club race (September 15 rain date)

October 13 - Club race
