

Minutes from the Monthly Meeting of the
Jefferson County Park Board

February 17, 2020

The Jefferson County Park Board gathered at the Broadway. President Gil McCoy called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m. with members Richard Hill and Nick Ellis in attendance. Kevin and Dale were out of town. The November minutes were read and approved.

Richard gave an update on the Brooksbury boat ramp. Some preparation for tree removal has begun. He has updated Sharon Stevens of the Brooksbury town council on the progress. Expect construction to begin this summer.

Nick will get with our mower (Scott Davis) to go over the trails to point out any areas he may have missed when removing unwanted trees across or in the paths of the trails.

Richard will check with Kevin on progress on the gravel, lights, and Aqua Shade for Krueger.
