

Minutes from the Monthly Meeting of the  
Jefferson County Park Board

May 6, 2019

The Jefferson County Park Board gathered at the Broadway. President Gil McCoy called the meeting to order at 5:18 p.m. with members Richard Hill, Nick Ellis, Kevin Lichlyter, and Dale Crafton in attendance. The April minutes were approved.

The primary topic of discussion was to create a list of maintenance projects that need to be completed for the parks. Dale provided a template that included the following: item/project, priority, description, justification, and approximate cost. The list and template for each project will be completed and submitted to the county commissioners this month in order to request funds in the upcoming county budget. The list and those responsible for obtaining estimates are:

Clearing the area east of Krueger of the sweet gum saplings, removing the downed trees, and mowing the field north of the lake: Nick will contact forester Abe Bear for his recommendations and cost estimates.

Spillway clearing: Kevin will contact some potential equipment operators.

Gravel for the roads around Krueger: Richard will look up the estimate that was previously done for cost of the gravel.

General maintenance on the two buildings at Kruger: Richard will contact a repair person to provide estimates.

Trail maintenance, signage, and maps. Nick will check on this.

Everyone will submit their respective estimates to Richard who will compile and submit them to the commissioners.

Kevin reported that a generous donor is willing to fund gravel for an extended parking area on the northwest side of Krueger and around the gazebo. It was noted that we discourage people from parking on the grass, but there is very little gravel area for parking. Kevin and Nick will go out to Krueger after the meeting to walk off and mark a proposed area.

Richard reported that he contacted Bill Seegers at DNR regarding the boat ramp at Brooksborg. Mr. Seegers informed that there is a mussel study yet to be completed. Once that is done, all the necessary studies, permits, etc. should be complete. He expects construction to begin later this summer.

The next meeting will be June 3, at 5:15, at the Broadway.
