

COMMISSIONERS MEETING

Commissioner David Bramer called the meeting to order, and led The Pledge of Allegiance along with Robert Little and Ron Lee. Commissioner Ron Lee made a motion to approve the previous meetings minutes, all accounts payable, and payroll claim dockets. Commissioner Robert Little seconded the motion on all accounts payable and payroll claim dockets, but abstained from the minutes because he was not present at the May 20th meeting. Motion passed 2/0; Motion passed 3/0 for minutes, accounts payable and payroll.

SIRPC Appointment- The County has had a vacancy on the Southeastern Indiana Regional Plan Commission. Commissioner Robert Little made a motion to appoint County Archivist & Grant Writer, Erica Cline to the board. Commissioner Ron Lee seconded the motion. Motion passed 3/0. Cline thanked the commissioners for the opportunity to serve on the board.

Health Department Doors & Windows Quote- Administrator, Tammy Monroe came to the meeting to ask the Commissioners to consider replacing the doors & windows in the Health Department. Monroe received a quote for the windows from Kinsinger's Custom Windows and a quote for windows and doors from glass unlimited. The commissioners asked Monroe to get a more descriptive quote from Kinsinger's for the windows to better compare between the two businesses. Monroe also said that the building also needs the new gutters. Commissioners advised Monroe to get a quote for the gutters and detail on the window quote and return to the next meeting.

Rick Anderson, Johnson Melloh Solutions- Rick Anderson presented a utility cost savings to the county regarding solar panels. Anderson said his company could perform a utility analysis of all the county buildings at no cost and report back to the commissioners on how the county couple potentially save money. The Commissioners thank Anderson for his presentation and are taking the analysis under advisement. Anderson is expected to return in about a month for a follow up.

Richard Carter- County resident, Richard Carter requested to be on the agenda today to provide updates on COVID statistics and request an update on the 2nd amendment sanctuary. Carter explained several statistics involving the use of Ivermectin to prevent the transmission of COVID. Carter also asked for a timeline on when the Commissioners would be passing an ordinance stating that no county money would be used to enforce federal gun laws. Carter stated he has provided the commissioners several copies of ordinances from other counties and expects the commissioners to create their own using the ordinances he provided.

Substance Abuse Reuse Committee: Commissioner Ron Lee invites everyone to the next meeting that will be held on June 17th at 3pm.

Jail Update- Commissioner Bramer stated that the bond sales were held today and the county should be receiving the final interest rates today. The rates are less that what was originally planned, therefore the overall payment for the facility will be less.

Commissioner Ron Lee made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Robert Little seconded. Motion passed 3/0.
