In attendance: County Council Members Pam Crozier, Joe Craig, Judy Smith, Ray Black, Heather Foy, Ray Denning, Chris Shelton, Sherry Eblen, Heather Huff taking minutes.

Pam Crozier called the meeting to order, and led all in attendance with The Pledge of Allegiance of The United States of America. Judy Smith made a motion to approve the minutes from 07-14-20 meeting. Ray Black seconded the motion. Motion passed 7/0.

Tammy Monroe- Jefferson County Health Department- Tammy updated the Council on the Health Departments efforts against COVID. The State of Indiana is requiring all counties to have testing site up and running. KDH will become the official testing site for Jefferson County. Tammy was also making the following transfer request.

Chris Shelton made a motion to approve the requested transfer. Joe Craig seconded the motion. Motion approved 7/0.

Bobby Little updated the Council on the needed repairs to the sewage grinder and pump station at the Health Department. Bobby presented two replacement options, after discussion the Council recommended the Health Department move forward with the option from Smith & Loveless/ American Repair Service. The Auditor will advertise an additional in the amount of \$75,000.00 from Cum Courthouse for next meeting.

Stephanie Back- Children's Advocacy Center- The Children's Advocacy Center serves Jefferson, Dearborn, Scott, and opening a new office in Greensburg soon. They offer forensic interviews for child abuse victims, as well as provide court appointed advocates. Stephanie was attending the meeting to request continued financial support from Jefferson County.

Tanner Mahoney & Mary Ellen Wehner- Jefferson County 4-H- Tanner Mahoney presented information on Jefferson County 4-H Association's history, amount of children served, and financial status. Mahoney and Wehner were making a request for continued financial support from the 2021 budget.

David Bramer & Bobby Little- Jefferson County Commissioners- The Commissioners updated the Council on the on the reading of an Ordinance pertaining to Internal Financial Controls, the ordinance will be presented to the Council at the next meeting.

Madison Precision Products & Jefferson County Assessor- Madison Precision Products represented themselves as they formally appealed a denial notice, due to an abatement application being turned in late. The Jefferson County Assessor's Office provided information on the application being filed 9 days late. Madison Precision Products explained the error. The Council discussed the amount of community involvement Madison Precision Products has. After much discussion Joe Craig made a motion to reinstate the abatement. Ray Black seconded the motion. Motion passed 6/1.

In discussion the Council requested The Auditor move \$250,000.00 from LIT to County General to compensate the additional requested earlier in the year by the Jefferson County Jail.
